The many and varied forms of Australian plant and animal life are depicted in stunning double page spreads, each showing a different environment.

CREATURES OF THE ANTARCTIC

Gough, S.

Big book plus 4 small books for middle/upper primary. This well set out book, beautifully illustrated with colour photographs and diagrams, looks at the many animals that inhabit the Antarctic region, their features, food and how they have adapted to their harsh environment.

A DINOSAUR DIRECTORY

Harney, S.

A wide variety of dinosaurs (quite a few of which inhabited Australia) are featured in this book which presents the facts that are known about their appearance and habits. The book also explains what the Earth would have been like in prehistoric times and how scientists are able to piece together information on dinosaurs from fossil remains. Middle primary.

ELEPHANTS

Pigdon, K.

The physical features, lifestyles and habitat of the largest land animal in the world.

HOW PLANTS GROW

Royston, A.

Colourful presentation with simple, clear text and detailed, brightly coloured photographs to introduce concepts about plant growth and reproduction. This big book discusses the parts of a plant and the importance of each part to the plant life cycle, and highlights the diversity among plant characteristics. Junior/middle primary.

INSECTS

Theodorou, R.

Excellent coloured photographs combine with clear headings and large print to demonstrate the life cycle of various insects. This book also shows how insects fit into the classification of animals and presents a chart comparing the features of the six main animal classes.

THE PLANETS

Tesar, J.

Large coloured photographs and clear diagrams are employed to introduce concepts about the solar system and the 9 planets. Each double page spread develops one topic and includes short text plus fact boxes. Teachers notes included. Junior/middle primary.

PREHISTORIC GIANTS

Sloan/Latham

A shared book on dinosaurs from the Australian Animal Series

SCHOOL : HISTORY FROM PHOTOGRAPHS

Cox, P.

A visual history of school life presented through the medium of coloured and black and white photographs. Each double page spread looks at an aspect of school with a photo of what happens today and a photo taken in the early 20th century. Big book format, useful at all primary levels.

THE SOLAR SYSTEM

Activities and information to help students to understand the solar system and how our planet is affected by, and relates to, the others planets and the sun. Upper primary.

SOUNDS OF THE FARM

Gold, K.

This big book is illustrated with large, clear, appealing, colour photographs. The simple, rhyming text at the top of each page poses a question relating to the particular sound of a farm animal. It is accompanied by a teaching guide full of ideas and activities to use with k-2.

THE WORLD OF ANTS LEAPING FROGS

Berger, M.

Simple text combines with stunning photography in these two big books to provide the story of each creature's life cycle. Junior primary. Each book has a separate Teacher's Guide.

BABY KOALA FINDS A HOME

Tripp, V.

Baby koala and her mother are searching for a place to stay. A repetitive story for K-2.

THE BATTLE OF ZORMLA

Hoban, R.

Hilarious story of 3 children involved in an exiting "battle". Junior - middle primary.

BIG RIG AND OTHER POEMS

A collection of poems about all kinds of transport – from drover's horses and Cob and Co. coaches to penny-farthings, steam trains and huge modern rigs. Upper primary.

DEAR GREENPEACE

James, S.

This big book features the letters between the Greenpeace organisation and a small girl who writes to tell them that she thinks there is a whale in her garden pond. Each double page spread presents a letter and a full page illustration. A delightful, humorous story that also provides some information about whales.
